

This ensures that cricket becomes a vehicle not only for physical development, but for character-building and long- term empowerment.



Facility Development Goals

We aim to upgrade and build cricket infrastructure in underresourced areas, starting with:

- Practice nets and pitches at Mfuleni Primary School
- Safe playing surfaces that meet coaching and match standards

These facilities will serve as hubs for ongoing training, tournaments, and community engagement.






